#### THE AUSTRALIAN SPELEOLOGICAL FEDERATION

The Australian Speleological Federation (ASF) was formed in 1956 to promote Australian speleology.

Membership was based on membership by clubs throughout Australia but in recent times an individual membership for cavers has been added.

Because of the tyranny of Australia's great distances, meetings of the ASF are difficult to arrange. The Bienniel Conference is an occasion for ASF committee meetings as well as a time for cavers to get together as Australian cavers.

#### **TROPICON**

The ASF has been holding bienniel conferences since the mid 1950's. These conferences have provided a meeting ground for cavers from all over Australia and the South Pacific Region.

Conference sessions first started as informal discussions and have since developed a more formal structure with highly informative papers balanced by down to earth and humorous papers.

A circuit of conferences has developed in a State by State sequence and this is the second conference to be held in Oueensland.

Tropicon represents a unique opportunity for cavers to come together to promote common ideals and to have friendly discussions about their differences (ie between sandgropers and banana benders etc)

Tropicon is being held at the Queensland Recreation Council's Lake Tinaroo Recreation Camp. Accommodation is dormitory style and is fully catered. Please supply your own linen as this is not available. Liquid refreshments will be on sale.

There is no public transport from Cairns to Tinaroo Falls township. 
#### OTHER TRIPS
