Speleosports

The Speleosports obstacle course was set up around the pre-primary playground at the school. Teams were of four people and all participants had to do each section, unless noted otherwise. The course consisted of the following:

- Crawl through two wooden picnic tables with attached benches.
- **The Sump** This involved diving through two packing crates full of 'simulated water' (empty plastic bottles) to locate and 'swim' through the sump (a short tube about 500mm in diameter connecting the two). On emerging from the bottles in the second crate, the first person had to reach through the timber bars of the crate to unlock a small padlock to release the 'gate'. A 5 second penalty accrued for each bottle not replaced when the team had finished.
- **Tyre squeeze** Two team members only had to squeeze through a set of 6 tyres hanging about 600mm apart.
- Participants followed a path through the playground equipment negotiating flying fox, balances, slides, climbs and a snaking route through the monkey bars. The sand was screeded and at certain points participants had to place their feet in the leader's footprints (minimal impact caving). 15 second penalty for any steps outside the leader's.
- **The Duck** Participants slid down a plastic tube into a bath full of water (cunningly roofed to ensure they got wet).
- The Squeeze A short zigzag flattener squeeze between two sheets of plywood.
- **The Straw Passage** This was a cardboard tube with lengths of spaghetti poked through holes in the top. Each broken straw incurred a 20 second penalty.
- **Climbing wall** Once all team members were through the straw tube, one member had to climb to the top of a climbing wall and ring the bell to finish.
