Thanks for the slide which arrived smashed despite your elaborate wrapping. Only the glass & plastic was broken. Fortunately the film came through unscathed so all is well.

I am glad to know that progress is being made on the "proceedings" or whatever you are calling it.

The photo was taken in Giants Cave, situated just north of Boranup, in South-west Western Australia. A diprotodon shot, with Norm Poulter's gas powered modified Diprotodon Hillii. Exposure 15 secs at F1.4 on Ektachrome X film using Nikkormat.

The Cave runs approximately E-W under the road between two entrances and this shot was taken looking west just into the first chamber west of the eastern entrance doline. I don't know if it has a name or not. Somebody else might.

In short, the label could be

"Cavescape, Giants Cave, Boranup, W.A."
but you have my permission to extemporize on the above information if that label is inadequate.
