WHYS AND WHEREFORES OF CAVE MAPPINGS. by EVALT CRABB

THIS ARTICLE WAS WRITTEN ABOUT TWO YEARS AGO, AND
THEREFORE, SINCE THAT TIME NEW AND EASIER WAYS HAVE
BEEN DISCOVERED, BOTH BY OUR OWN EXPERIENCES AND
FROM OTHER PEOPLE. A NEWER VERSION WILL BE WRITTEN UP LATER.
THE MAPPING:

THERE ARE SEVERAL REASONS FOR ACCURATE MAPPING OF CAVE SYSTEMS, — THE MAIN ONES BEING: (1), FOR THE GHIDANCE OF FUTURE VISITORS TO THE AREA, (2). TO PROVIDE A BASIS FOR THE EXPLORATION OF NEW TUNNELS IN COMPLICATED SYSTEMS THAT MAY BE OVERLOOKED, (3). TO PROVIDE A BASIS FOR EXPLORATION FOR FORMATIONS AT CERTAIN LEVELS, (4) TO CHECK FOR POSSIBLE LINKS WITH OTHER CAVES IN THE AREA.

TO FULLFILL THE REQUIREMENTS OF A MAP FOR THE ABOVE PURPOSES

THE IMPORTANT POINTS ARE LENGTH, DEPTH AND DIRECTION OF TUNNELS,

NOTES ON ANY FEATURES THAT CAN BE USED AS LANDMARKS, AND A

NOTE OF ANY DANGER SPOTS.

WAS CHOSEN BECAUSE (1) THE S.S.S. ARE CARRYING OUT A SURFACE SURVEY OF THE AREA, AND CORELATION TO OTHER CAVES WOULD BE EASY AND ACCURATE (2). THE CAVE IS SUFFICIENTLY COMPLICATED TO PROVIDE INTEREST OTHER THAN ACTUAL MAPPING, (3). MOVEMENT THROUGH THE CAVE IS RELATIVELY SIMPLE, (4). CHECKING THE ACCURACY OF THE METHOD

PASE 4. 60:10.

OF MAPPING IS POSSIBLE DUE TO DYERLAPPING TUNNELS AND A VENT IN THE ROOF NEAR THE ENTRANCE

THE EQUIPMENT REQUIRED CONSISTS OF A CORD, WITH LENGTHS MARKED A COMPASS, AND A DEVISE FOR MEASURING THE ANGLE OF THE CORD, RELATIVE TO VERTICAL OR HORIZONTAL THE CORD IS STRETCHED BETWEEN FIXED POINTS AS FAR APART AS POSSIBLE, CONSISTENT WITH THE SHAPE OF THE CAVE AND THE DISTANCE, DIRECTION AND ANGLE CHECKED THESE ARE NOTED, TOGETHER WITH A ROUGH PLAN SHOWING WIDTH OF THE TUNNEL, BRANCH TUNNELS, AND ANY SALIENT FEATURES THIS IS THEN REPEATED UNTIL . EACH TUNNEL BECOMES IMPASSABLE. AN IMPORTANT POINT IS THE SETTING OF BASE DATUM POINTS, I.E. THE ESTABLISHMENT OF FIXED, RECOGNISABLE POINTS AT WELL KNOWN SECTIONS OF THE SYSTEM. THEN, ANY MAPPING WOULD BE DONE RELATIVE TO THESE POINTS, WHICH SHOULD BE NEAR JUNCTIONS IT IS SUGGESTED THAT THESE BASE DATUM POINTS BE ESTABLISHED IN THE GRILLE CAVE AT THE OUTSIDE ENTRANCE, AT THE BASE OF THE LONG LADDER, AT THE TOP OF THE LONG MUDDY SLOPE, AND AT THE LARGE CHAMBER BEYOND AND BELOW THE CRUCIFIX. GROTTO (CRYSTAL PALACE); THEY WILL BE RECOGNISED BY THE LETTERS A, B, C,+ D, RESPECTIVELY EACH LIME SURVEY, THEN WILL BE THOULATED NUMERICIALLY ACCORDING TO IT'S POSITION, e.g. B+ 2, C+1, etc.

THE PROCEDURE IN THE CAVES WILL BE AS FOLLOWS: A SPECIAL NOTEBOOK WILL BE KEPT, EACH PAGE OF WHICH WILL BE DEVOTED TO A SINGLE LINE SURVEY. EACH PAGE WILL HAVE.

(1) THE INDEX NUMBER OF THE LINE, I.C. A+1, A+2.

- (2) THELENGTH OF THE LINE FROM POINT TO POINT.
- (3) THE DIRECTION OF THE LINE.
- (4) THE ANGLE OF THE LINE RELATIVE TO THE HORIZON TAL.
- (5) IF ONE POINT HAPPENS TO BEA BASE DATUM, DETAILS OF THE POSITITION OF the POINT.
- (6) A ROUGH SKETCH OF THE CAVE RELATIVE TO THE LINE, WITH MOPROXIMATE DIDTHS MARKED, AND SPECIAL FEATURES, SUCH AS LEDGES, POOLS, OR LARGE FORMATIONS. THIS SKETCH WILL ALSO INCLUDE THE ENTRANCE OF ANY SIDE TUNNELS, WITH THEIR GEOMETRIC POSITION ACCURATELY DIMENSIONED
 - (7). A NOTE OF ANY MARKER LEFT FOR REFERENCE

WHEN A LONG TRUP INTO THE CAVE IS CONTEMPLATED, ITWOULD BE DESIRABLE TO COMMENCE MEPPING AT ONE OF THE LOWER LEVELS, SO THAT PURELY, EXPLORATORY WORK MAY BE CHRRIED OUT AT THE SAME TIME, THE AREA. IMMEDIATELY INSIDE THE ENTRANCE CAN BE MAPPED WHEN SWITHBUE SHORT, OCCASIONS PERMIT, OR WHEN NEW PEOPLE ARE BEING SHOWN THE FORMATIONS, PERMITTING SPLITTING OF THE ADVANCE GROW! ON THESE SHORT TRIPS ALSO, IS INTENDED THAT THE SHORT SIDE TRUNKELS BE FOLLOWED AND MAPPED

AS THE AROVE SURVEY WILL BE CARRIEDOUT OVER SEVERLTRIPS TO THE AREA, IT'S INTERDED THAT THE DRAWING OF THE MAP BE DONE PROGRESSIVLY A LARGE SCALE MAD OF THE CAVE ONLY, And a smaller map, To THE Same SCALE AS THE S.S. SURVEY, WILL BE PREPARED, And WILL consist of a TRUE PLAN VIEW, WITH PROGRESSIVE DEPTHS MARKED IN THIS WAY IT WILL BE POSSIBLE TO DECIDE IN WHICH DIRECTION FURTHER EXPLORATION SHOULD BE CARTIED OUT PRIST, THE AIM BEING TO LINE IP POSSIBLE WITH OTHER SYSTEMS NEARTHE GRILLE CONE.

A START WAS MADE IN MAPPING THE GRILLE CAVE ON THE 2nd and 3nd OF AUGUST, 1958. THE HREA BETWEEN "A" F" B" DATUMS HAVE BEEN COVERED.

BY A LINE TRAVERSE, INDICATING THAT THE BASE OF THE LONG LADDER? IS APPROXIMATELY 130 FEET BELOW THE ENTRANCE. COMPLETE MOPPING IN THE AREAS BETWEEN A" and "B' DATUMS and "Band" DATUMS WOULD BE A LONG AND "HIBORIOUS JOB. There may BE A WATER COURSE TO THE LOWER LEVELS IN DETWEEN "B" and "C" DATUMS, OTHER THAN THAT FOLLOWING FROM "B" DATUM. From "C" TO D' DATUMS IS REASONABLE STRAIGHT FORWARD, AND When time permits this AREA.

CAN BE FULLY MAPPED.

IT IS PROPOSED THAT FOUR NEW DATUM POINTS BE ESTABLISHED,

IDENTIFED AS "E" F"G" md'H" THESE ARE TO BE RESPECTIVELY HT A

SINCE THIS ARTICLE WAS WRITTEN WE HAVE DONE A LINE
SURVEY AS FAR AS THE BAT CHAMBER WHICH IS APPROXIMATELY 250 FT
BELOW THE ENTRANCE. SOME FULL MAPPING HAS BEEN DONE ON
THIS PART ALSO BUT FOUL AIR HAS STOPPED US IN PROGRESSING
ANY FURTHER, IN DEPTH.

REPORT ON BUNGONIA CAVES TRIP. 17-18 SEPTEMBER 1960.

AFTER A SLIGHT DELAY, ON SATURDAY MORNING, DUE TO CAR REPAIRS,

THE TRIP STARTED, WITH ELEVEN PEOPLE TRAVELLING IN THREE CARS.

THERE WAS A DELAY ON THE WAY, AS ONE OF THE VEHICLES SUFFERED A PUNCTURE

THE DAY TIME START WAS TAKEN ADVANTAGE OF BY GEOFF, WHO TOOK MOVIE

FILM SHOTS OF THE TRIP ON THE FORWARD JOURNEY. EARLY LUNCH, WAS

TAKEN AT MARULAN.

A STOP WAS MADE JUST BEFORE THE RESERVE ENTRANCE TO ENABLE A LOOK-SEE TO BE TAKEN OF THE LIMESTONE OUTCROPS IN THAT AREA.

ONE FAIR SIZED ENTRANCE WAS FOUND, UNPORTUNATELY THOUGH THERE HAD BEEN A LOT OF RUBBISH DEPOSITED IN THE ENTRANCE.

ON OUR ARRIVAL AT THE CAMP SITE, (NOT THE USUAL ONE), AS IT WAS OCCUPIED, FIVE OF THE GROUP WENT INTO THE GRILLE CAVE TO OCHECK ON FOUR AIR. THIS WAS FOUND TO BE AT THE PREVIOUS LEVEL I.C. AFTER THIS DISCOVERY, AND WHILE CAMP WAS BEING LADE SHIP SHAPE EVALT AND ROSS WENT AND HAD A LOOK AT THE NEW CAVE THAT HAD BEEN RECENTLY RE-DISCOVERED BY U.N.S.W.S.S. (B31.) SATURDAY EVENING FOUND THE GROUP CLUSTERED AROUND THE TOP OF B.). OF THE EIGHT THAT WENT DOWN, ONLY TWO HAD BEEN DOWN BEFORE, DAVID AND EV, THE DITHER SIX WERE KEN, JOHN, LES, BOB, GRAHAME AND KEITH. KEITH STAYED IN THE LITTLE CHAMBER AT THE BOTTOM OF THE FIRST DROP, BUT THE OTHERS WERE SHOWN TO THE DROP WHERE WE NEED A LADDER TO GO FURTHUR, SURPRISINGLY ENOUGH IT WAS AN EARLY NIGHT FOR EVERYONE.

NEXT MORNING, EVERYONE WAS UP FRITRLY EARLY EVEN OUT illustrious leader BEAT TWO OF OUR members up in accordance with the new ideas THAT WERE TOBETRIED OUT, THE PARTY WAS SPLIT INTO 3 GROUPS. THE GREATER NUMBER, JOHN KETI, LES and ROSS, WENT TO EXPLORE B31, A VERY DUSTY And narrow CAVE, AS FAR AS WE GOT, WHERE A HOLE WAS REACRIED (ABOUT 50-60 FT) WHERE A LADDER WOULD BE NEEDED FOR FURTHUR EXPLORATION LES REPORTS FINDING ANOTHER HOLE THAT SEEMS TO CONTINUE ON IN THE TOP OF ONE OF THE CHAMBERS (FURTHER WORK REGUIRED DICKING!) THE Group CONSISTING OF EV, BOB and GRAHAMS WITH JOHN AS CHIEFHOLE-FINDER. WENT LOOKING FOR THE LITTLE KNOWN COVES AND POT-HOLES IN THE CHAMBERS. HITTLE KNOWN COVES AND POT-HOLES IN THE CHAMBERS.
