After reading last month's mag. about the Penguins' raid on our Dolphin, we will gladly attend their next function if they will kindly let us know of the date.

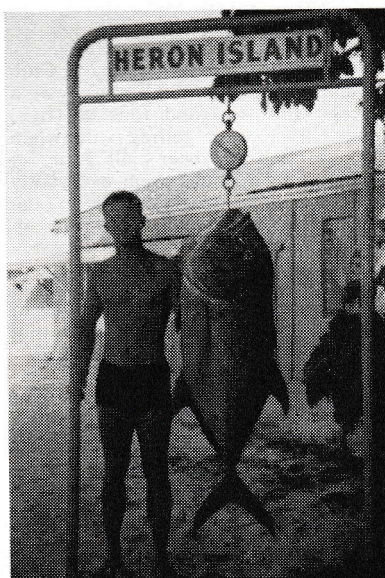
A club shirt is in the process of being made, which will have a dolphin in a circle on the back. For your orders please contact Barry Funnel with your sizes.
