SUPPLYING OF MATERIAL TO STAGING CONNECTIONS

Staging connections offer is:-

-S.P.D supply original slides to be programmed into an A.V by Staging Connections with music by Staging Connections.

-The A.V is envisioned to be a three screen, 9 projector using a 2 on 1 lap panorama type of format (ie. similar to Bob Smith's original presentation)

-There would be no cost direct to S.P.D except the loan of the original slides.

-S.P.D would use this presentation at the 1988 awards.

-The type of presentation is such that we do not have the facilities to arrange such a show without spending many hours (at \$100 per hour) in the studios of Staging Connections or a similar organisation.

-The saving to the club cannot be estimated, however an A.V. we can do ourselves would cost approximately \$700 so that amount is a starting point.

-Channel Nine will, if they think it is suitable, use the program on their Wide World of Sports show. The T.V. station is in fact paying all costs.

-At a later date, if and when the situation arises Staging Connections may hire out the program. If this occurs S.P.D. will be paid a fee.

-Rather than accept cash it is suggested that credit should be transferred to our account.

WHAT WILL BE THE COST TO S.P.D

-If individual members supply slides on behalf of the club the only cost that could be envisaged would be in the case of lost or misplaced slides. As the company specialises in handling slides this would seem to be a very improbable occurrence but certainly should not be ignored.

-Additional projectors on the night may be a possibility to cover the special lapping system.

GAINS TO BE MADE BY STAGING CONNECTIONS

-The company paying will be Channel Nine. The idea is an experiment to use A.V's on T.V, thought up by Greg White who works for Staging Connections but is sub contracted to Channel Nine. If we proceed they will have to access to slides at low cost. If we do not they will use another event for which they will use in house photographers so the cost to them will still be negligible.

Therefore would the members think of any questions they wish to raise concerning the above matter and discuss them at the September meeting. A decision of yes or no should be made on this matter at the meeting as this issue is dragging on and wasting time at our meetings and elsewhere.

1. The competition will be conducted over three months.

Each month's competition will close at 11.00 p.m. on the night of the Club meeting for that month:

- September
- October
- November

Late entries will be entered into the following month's competition.

2. The competition is open only to members of South Pacific Divers who are currently financial.

3. September Competition is open only to those people who have not gained 1st, 2nd or 3rd in any competition with the exception of past George Roberts Novice Sections.

October Competition is open to any person except those people who have won 1st in Oceans or 1st, 2nd or 3rd open in past S.P.D. Competitions.

November Competition is open to all members.

4. Each entry may be up to five slides per month. They will be judged and only the highest scoring slide counted.
5. There will be a prize winner each month and a major overall prize winner.
6. The winner and entrants each month will receive a score for the place they achieve (different from their slides score). This score is cumulative through the competition. The highest cumulative score at the end of the competition will be declared the overall winner. The scores each month will be:
