

- Day 3 - On Mana Island - Accommodation is in twin bures (fijian style

- Diving during this time will be at your leisure. Boats will be available for a nominal hire charge - these can take 10 divers comfortably - or you can just walk in off the beach.
- Water skiing, and sailing craft are available daily for those who want a rest from diving. HOWEVER we guarantee that you won't ever tire of the diving around Mana.
- Day 11 We must leave Mana in the late afternoon, by launch for the mainland. We will once again transfer from Lautoka to Nadi for accommodation for two nites.
- Day 12 At leisure in Nadi. This day specifically set aside for duty free shopping in the many small shops that abound in this town.

Our international jet flight departs early for Sydney the following morning, arriving in Sydney in time for work (that dreadful word) on Monday morning.
