PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE CLUB'S RULES OF INCORPORATION

The following amendments to the Club's Rules of Incorporation have been proposed by some members of the Club. It is intended that they be considered and voted on at the June meeting.

Rule 22(a)

Amend to read:

22 (a) An Annual General Meeting of the Association shall be held each year within three (3) months of the end of the membership year of the Association.

Reason:

At the present time the AGM must be held before the end of September. With a move to holding the AUPY Presentation night later in the year, it would mean that the committee who have done all the work organising the competition and night would (possibly) be removed only days before the event. This would cause numerous problems.

Rule 6

Delete and insert following:

- 6 (a) Subject to the Associations Incorporation Act 1984 and the rules of the Association, a member or officer of the Association shall not by reason only of being such a member of officer be liable to contribute towards the payments of the debts or liabilities if the Association or the costs, charges and expenses of the winding up of the Association.
- 6 (b) Subject to the Associations Incorporation Act 1984, membership of the Association does not confer upon members of the Association any right, title or interest, whether legal or equitable, in the property of the Association.

Reason:

Current wording is not consistent with Section 16 of the Associations Incorporation Act 1984.

Rule 13 (a) and 13 (b)

Insert the following additional clauses and renumber as necessary:

- 13 (a) (vi) The member becomes an insolvent under administration within the meaning of the Companies (NSW) Code.
- 13 (a) (vi) The member becomes of unsound mind or a person whose person or estate is liable to be dealt with in any way under the law relating to mental health.
- 13 (a) (vi) The member is absent without the consent of the committee from all meetings of the committee held during a period of 6 months.

Repeat for rule 13 (b)

Reason:

Current wording is not consistent with the Associations Incorporation Act 1984.
