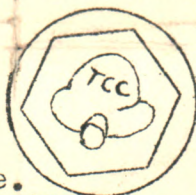

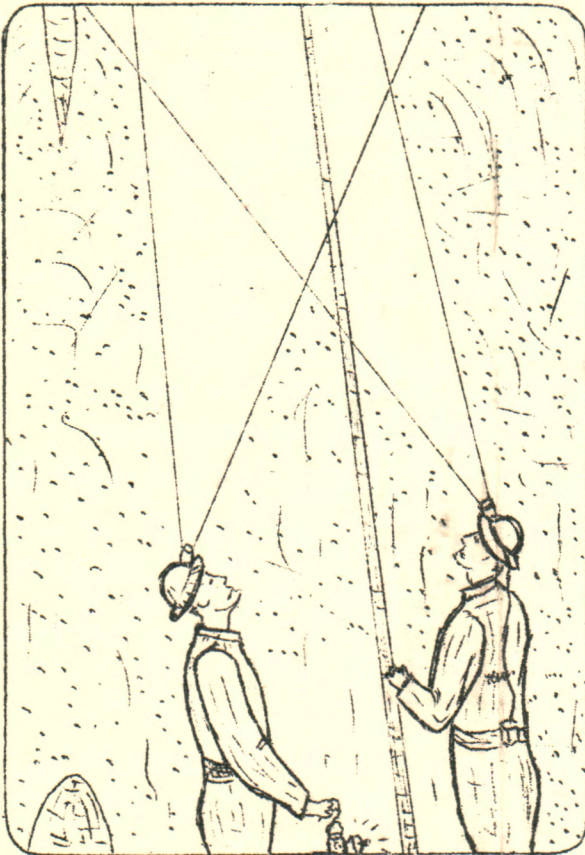
JAMES' MEMORIAL HUT.
