Conservation status

There is very little information available about Kim Binh proposed cultural and historical site. In 1991, Kim Binh was included on Decision No. 1057/VHQD of the Ministry of Cultural and Information, which proposed establishing a 1,937 ha cultural and historical site. In 1994, an investment plan was prepared for the cultural and historical site (FPD 1998).

Kim Binh is included on the 2010 list as a 1,937 ha cultural and historical site, including 900 ha of forest (FPD 1998). The site is currently under the management of Tuyen Quang Provincial DARD, with an area of 2,223 ha (Tuyen Quang Provincial FPD 2000).

Topography and hydrology

Kim Binh proposed cultural and historical site is located in Kim Binh commune, Chiem Hoa district. The site is situated in an area of low mountains to the east of Chiem Hoa town, and ranges in elevation from approximately 200 to 500 m. The site is situated in the watershed of the Gam river.
