#### Conservation status

There is very little information available about My Bang proposed cultural and historical site. According to MARD (1997), the establishment of a 3,403 ha cultural and historical site was proposed, presumably by either Tuyen Quang Provincial People's Committee or the Ministry of Culture and Information. According to Tuyen Quang Provincial FPD (2000), however, the area of the site is 969 ha. However, no investment plan has been prepared for the site and a management board has not been formed. My Bang is currently under the management of Tuyen Quang Provincial DARD (Tuyen Quang Provincial FPD 2000). My Bang is not included on the 2010 list.

## Topography and hydrology

My Bang proposed cultural and historical site is located in My Bang commune, Yen Son district. The topography of the proposed cultural and historical site is characterised by limestone karst. Streams originating in the site flow into the Chay river, a tributary of the Lo river, which joins the Red River at Viet Tri town.

### **Biodiversity value**

Remote sensing data indicate that My Bang proposed cultural and historical site is primarily under agricultural land uses Consequently, the site can be expected to have little or no biodiversity value, although an assessment of the biodiversity value of the site has not yet been carried out.

#### Conservation issues

No information.

#### Other documented values

My Bang was proposed as a cultural and historical site because of its historical importance (MARD 1997), although the nature of this historical importance is not known.
