Conservation status

The current status of Nui Chung is unclear. The establishment of a cultural and historical site at Nui Chung was approved in 1989, presumably by either the Ministry of Culture and Information or Nghe An Provincial People's Committee (MARD 1997). Subsequently, the 2010 list proposed including Nui Chung within the Special-use Forests network as a 600 ha cultural and historical site (FPD 1998).

Topography and hydrology

Biodiversity value

The vegetation at the site is dominated by plantation forest (Vu Van Dung pers. comm.).

Other documented values

Nui Chung proposed cultural and historical site protects the landscape around Ho Chi Minh's native village in Kim Lien commune, Nam Dan district. The site, consequently, has high cultural, historical and tourism values, and receives tens of thousands of domestic tourists annually.
