Notes on PDF reprint of Association for Mexican Cave Studies Newsletter, volume 4:

Volume 4 was edited by James Reddell and William Elliott, produced by Terry Raines, and published irregularly in five issues, as shown in the table.

The PDF consists of scans of the pages and hence consists entirely of graphics images. The text is not searchable by the PDF-reader program.

The numbers in this volume were saddle-stapled into gray cover sheets. The printing on the front cover is the same as that on the first regular page of each issue, but the back of the cover contains the masthead and the back of the first page contains other material, so both pages are included in the PDF file, which is set up for 2-sided printing, with blank pages where necessary. The back covers contained only publications catalog material that is obsolete, and they are not included in the file.

Because page numbers were not assigned to the covers, the page numbers in the PDF file become increasingly different from the original page numbers in the issues. The table shows where in the PDF the cover for each issue appears and also the first original page number in the issue. For example, original page 111 appears on PDF page 119, because the cover to number 4 takes up two pages.

The index, which was published separately without a cover, appears following the last issue and a blank cover sheet added to the file. The index itself starts on PDF page 203.

The last number, 5-6, was accompanied by six loose, folded maps, which are included in a separate PDF file. They originally varied in size, but have been made uniformly 11 by 17 inches, the largest size conveniently available for computer printing. Note that, unlike the foldouts in volumes 2 and 3, these maps do not also appear on pages in the regular PDF.
