## **Abstract**

The Argentinean Federation of Speleology (FAE), in conjunction with the Commission of Libraries, is involved in a project to organize all documentation concerning caves available in the country (books, journals, videos, etc.). This information has been united in a single data bank (Sistema Micro Isis). With this in mind, libraries and other spelological groups were contacted and a system was devised to share the information available. The data base distributed by the National Commission of Atomic Energy made it possible to classify the material identified. At present, 100 journal collections and 400 books, as well as pamphlets, bulletins, and special materials have been catalogued, and this catalog will be presented.
