EXPLANATORY NOTES

The list is inevitably incomplete. Many items listed have not yet been sighted, and numerous errors are apparent or implied. The subject coding of items is very preliminary.

Items identified in the subject lists are cited in full in a single list of references at the end. It is intended that annotations will be progressively accumulated for all items listed. No responsibility is taken for balance, relevance or coverage of annotations.

Conventions used

Official government publications are generally listed under the relevant department or authority name, prefixed by the name of the country, state or territory. Where individual authors are clearly identified, the item is listed under the names of the author rather than the department.

Filing is alphabetical to the level of individual family names and first initial. However, variation in the citation of given names and initials [usually as given in the document concerned, if seen] is ignored. For example, "BLOGGS J C" and "BLOGGS Joe" are regarded as the same. Instead, date is then used to sort items into chronological order. Punctuation and ampersands among compound authors are ignored. "ed.", "eds", "compiler" and the like are also ignored. "Mc" or "O' " names are listed as "MC" or "O", followed by a space and then the rest of the name; these sort with the space coming before the A's at the second or third letter. "De", "Le" or "Mac" names are only treated similarly if the correct usage for the particular name involves two words.
