
## **Kerry numbered 'Real Photo' Cards.**

We now come to the various 'real photo' cards produced by, or attributable to, Kerry. Some similar cards that are attributed to Trickett (but published by Kerry) are also included here. As explained in the introduction, the backs of these cards have no necessary systematic relationship to card series, but are simply a product of the print stock to hand at the time.

JKJK86 Individually numbered cards, printed in black-&-white (usually faded to sepia – and it is likely that many were originally printed in sepia toning)

JKJK87 Individually numbered cards printed as photographs and hand-coloured. In many cases, the colours have blurred, even to the extent where it is almost impossible to recognise the view. We also include here two un-numbered cards which otherwise 'fit'here.


N.B. In series JKJK86 & JKJK87, we have incorporated the number on the card into our own number. Where the same image appears in various formats, an additional letter is used.
