


## Real Photo Cards of Uncertain Provenance

The series listed here are all of uncertain origin. Although many are based upon Kerry negatives, they were apparently published following the closedown of the Kerry business. At this stage, there is no adequate evidence of who was responsible, but one might reasonably assume that most were produced by the tourist Bureau.

### JK88. Kerry / Trickett Large Title Series

This is an enigmatic series, distinguished by the unusually large lettering of titles in Italic caps. & l.c. Several cards as noted below are identified in Trickett's Guidebooks as his own, and another appears in the guidebooks without identification.

These were doubtless published in several series, but it is difficult to find simple criteria that would serve to identify such series. Accordingly, they are listed in geographic sequence for ease of reference, but with gaps in numbering to provide for further cards being identified.

One copy has message "*We drove through this arch on the way to the House. At night it is lit up with electricity. The band was down here last night for the General's benefit.*" This may well refer to the formal visit of a French mission under the leadership of General Pau, whose visit to Jenolan was reported in the Sydney Mail of 25 September 1JK918. The general is quoted as saying ". . . he was reminded of the limestone caves of France, but they were dwarfed by those of Jenolan, and he had never anticipated anything on so grand a scale. The wonderful colouring, the curious formation - in short, everything connected with Jenolan Caves was on a scale infinitely beyond compare." Clearly, the general either had a limited knowledge of the French caves, or was a good diplomat !
