## Jenolan Anthony ('Tant') Bradley Postcards

Anthony Harris Mosby ('Tant') Bradley came to Jenolan in 1916. His grandfather, then father, had both been 'keeper' of the Yarrangobilly Caves and Bradley himself had guided parties of visitors at Yarrangobilly since the age of 10. He also assisted in the discovery and exploration of a number of caves at Yarrangobilly, and in 1907-8 had built the major pathways of the area, many of which remain to this day (Middleton 1972, 1985a, 1985b). At Jenolan, he worked as a guide under the direction of J.C. Wiburd, and in 1932, succeeded him as chief guide and remained in that capacity until 1947. During part of that time (it is not clear exactly when or for how long) he produced postcards that were marketed at the caves kiosk. The very few dated cards we have seen come only from 1928-29.

[There was a story told to us by a director of the Department of Tourism that some years ago one officer at the caves had improperly produced and sold postcards, more or less as a private business. Action had been taken by the department to ensure that such a practice did not continue! We suspect this refers to Bradley, as there is no evidence of any other officer of the department doing so.]

We also have a series of Bradley's negatives, many of which have a superimposed title and were evidently used as the basis of postcards. It has also been possible to further place his work in context, and it appears that he was at least influenced by, and probably closely associated with, Harry Phillips. We list those cards that we have seen as the JB series below, then append a further listing of the prints we have taken from the negative collections, some of which are included in the JB listing.

There are probably many further cards that we have not yet seen, as many of the negatives listed in the file are missing and most of the known postcards are from other negatives not included in the file.
