BUNDANOON

At Bundanoon in the Southern Highlands, a small creek has carved out an almost subterranean course through sandstones for a short distance, and this is commonly referred to as the Bundanoon Cave. It has long been known as a habitat of the glowworm - the larvae of a fly (Arachnocampa sp.) which has a luminous organ at the end of the abdomen in both larval and adult stages.
