3.1 The Cave Falls/Somersby/Gosford 1787 H

On the R.H. side of the view the lettering "Petch & Son/Livery /Gosford/Phone 26" appears. The ms. on the back of the card says "Another one of the 8 or more Somersby Falls. ... The advertisement for Petch & Sons is cut right in the rock, not painted on as it appears to be in this photo"

4. F.P. HOBBS SERIES [n.l. 1908]

F Real photo card with small photograph surrounded by hand-coloured Art Deco Frame. Has words 'Happy New Year: Good Luck' and imprint 'F.P. Hobbs Copyright'.

4.1 The Cave House/North Sydney H [pm. 23 Dec. 1908]

Depicts what appears to be a relatively elaborate camp located within a rock shelter.

5. THE HYDE PARK GROTTTO

Obviously not a cave - but a constructed arch with ferns, assumed to mimic a cave, as one of the landscape features of a park. Such Grottoes were fashionable in the British

pleasure gardens of the 18th and early 19th centuries, and Alexander Pope is notorious for having arranged for stalactites to be 'shot down' from Wookey Hole for the embellishment of a grotto.

 - Marjorie's Glen / Roseville Park / Middle Harbour V (Depicts man with hand in stream running from under a sandstone overhang. [pm. 1908])
