Port Campbell

Port Campbell is a spectacular coastal area, with cliffs, a major gorge and a series of seastacks, commonly known as the Twelve Apostles. Loch Ard Gorge, which is the site of most of the caves, is named after a ship that was wrecked at just this spot. The only two survivors of the wreck were an apprentice sailor called Tom Pearce and a lady from the Government House staff of the day called Eve Carmichael. Each is commemorated in the name of a cave.
