This card shows two young men wearing suits and laying against a rock which in turn overlooks a pool in a stream. No cave is immediately obvious, although there are crannies between boulders. The name 'Gosdin's Caves' is in ms. on the back of the card in the same hand as Robe 2.1 and the two cards were bought from the same vendor. We thus assume that the view is somewhere in South Australia, but this may not be the case. The cards have no other title or imprint and appear to be personal photographs.

S. Aust.: Kangaroo Island

The major caves on Kangaroo Island are at Kelly Hill, and although these were discovered in 1925 and rapidly became popular, we have not yet seen other than contemporary postcards from there.

As around much of the Southern coastline, there are a number of caves and arches along the sea cliffs also, and at least one of these does appear on a card.

Mt. Gambier is a young volcanic feature, well-known for its Blue

Lake, situated in the former crater. Two well-known karst features occur - Umpherston's Cave and Town Cave. Both are in fact only dolines and neither give access to a true cave. The first is a popular picnic spot, and forms a massive amphitheatre, sometimes used for band concerts. The Town Cave is used as a storm-water catchment, but its surroundings are attractively landscaped and planted with ornamental gardens.
